Qualifying races will be run on Saturday, starting at 10:00 a.m. This is a first come, first served process, so as entries are received they will be entered into a race. All races will be open for on-site registration on the day of the event.

- Enclose a check or money order for \$15.00 payable to the <u>CASA of Grayson County</u>.
- Be sure to include your telephone number, address, city, zip code & email address.
- Sign the responsible party clause and mail your completed form to:

- Registrations without signatures will not be processed, and dogs will not be able to race.
- <u>Shot Records are required.</u> Send a <u>copy</u> of shot records with the registration. Registrations without shot records will not be assigned to a race until shot records are received.
- If you plan to register on site, you must bring a <u>copy</u> of the shot records <u>to be kept</u> with the registration form. Same rules apply as for the early registrations; registrations without shot records will not be assigned a race until records are received. Current tags will not suffice.
- Race assignments will be emailed if email addresses are provided on the registration form.
- **PayPal** will again be available for payment, **HOWEVER**, you **must** still send in the **registration form and shot records**. Without that information your dog cannot get placed into a race.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

- All dachshunds will be checked by a Veterinarian prior to their race at staging. Dogs must be certified dachshunds This does not mean they have to be AKC registered, but must have the specific breed characteristics as stated by the AKC. Veterinarians will be on site to make sure dogs are qualified dachshunds and not a mixed breed. <u>Mixed breeds can race only in the Mixed Breed category.</u> Chi-weenies are considered a mixed breed. CASA has the right to disqualify any dog if there is a question of the breed or size.
- All dogs must have current shots. Rabies in particular.
- Races are assigned by order of receipt of a complete registration packet, i.e., registration form, entry fee check and current shot record.
- You may bring your dog's favorite toy. (Toy may not be bigger than **<u>8 inches</u>**).
- <u>No food (human or dog food) or other pets are allowed in racetrack area.</u>
- All dogs <u>MUST</u> be on a leash.
- Owners are required to clean-up after their dog's accidents.
- Dogs should be on their best behavior (i.e. no fighting, biting or aggressiveness)
- Only <u>one</u> owner/handler allowed in the racetrack area at any time.
- No waving blankets or other large items at the start of the race.
- The **first and second place dogs** from each race on Saturday morning qualify for the finals and must return Saturday at 1:00 p.m. to compete in the finals.
